Dear Scoutmaster:

Do you have any good youth leaders that have completed the National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) course? I would like to extend an invitation to them to interview for the position of Youth Staff at the upcoming NYLT course. Please let me know if you have any youth that are interested and would be a good candidate for our youth staff.

For one week, Scouts from across the council will be taught leadership skills and ways to implement them. This is designed to be a practical course, in hopes that the Scout will take the knowledge back to his home troop and implement his new skills in the troop setting.

Scouts meeting the criteria need to complete the application and **return it to my attention no later than DECEMBER 7, 2007!** The application process is simple:

- The Scout needs to complete the “**INFORMATION SECTION**” on the enclosed *Youth Staff Information Sheet*, and sign the form at the bottom.
- The parents or guardians need to complete and sign the “**PARENT SECTION**”.
- You will need to complete the “**SCOUTMASTER SECTION**”. Have the Scout make out a mailing envelope (*addressed to me at the above address*), put a stamp on it, and mail the forms to my attention.

Our first meeting we will have interviews for the new potential staff and a post conference reflection/interviews for the returning NYLT staff. The Scout will arrive in **full uniform** before 7 pm Friday, January 11, 2007 with pens, pencils, paper and sleeping bags and a great **Scouting Attitude**. We will have pizza Friday night and breakfast and lunch on Saturday. Will need to have their NYLT Pin earned to be on staff, Note: *full uniform is Scout shirt, pants, belt, socks, t-shirt ----this will be our required uniform from here on in*  
It would be nice to meet the Parents when the Scouts get picked up on Saturday, so please be sure to invite them in so we can meet them and answer any questions they might have.
