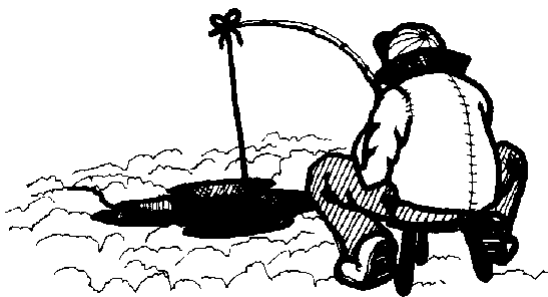


Activity: Ice Fishing!

Details: Come to Troop 72's first-ever ice fishing weekend! Mr. Cory Krizan led our Scouts on an ice fishing day in April 2011, and it was so much fun that this time we're going to make a weekend out of it with a normal Friday night to Sunday afternoon campout. We'll be staying at the "Sour Dough" cabin (featuring heat and running water) at Camp Phillips, about an hour's drive up Highway 53. Scouts are welcome to try sleeping outside, too, if they want some extra adventure.

We'll get up VERY early Saturday and drive to whatever lake Mr. Krizan recommends. After we're done fishing, we'll return to our cabin and cook up whatever we caught for supper. (We'll have some backup food, too, of course!)

(NOTE: If this extra-mild winter weather continues, the ice may be too thin for ice fishing! In that case, we will do something else Saturday...maybe water skiing?!) (Although keep in mind that we'll be 60 miles further north than Chippewa Falls, so maybe we'll be okay.)
